2020 Scholarship Application Guidelines

*Items 1 – 5 must be attached for the application to be considered
(if any of the items are not turned in by the deadline, your application will not be reviewed)*

1. Prepare and type a 250-word essay on the following topic:
“After graduating from college, I plan to achieve...”
Discuss in detail your plans for the future, including what you plan to study in college and why.
Handwritten essays will not be accepted
2. An official copy of your first grading period report card (must have a minimum 2.5 GPA)
3. A copy of the Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – Electronic Student Aid Report (SAR)
4. A recommendation letter from a teacher or guidance counselor
5. A photograph of yourself (you should be the only one in the picture)
6. Must complete a minimum of 20 volunteer hours at the Akron Urban League after you have been awarded a scholarship

In order to receive an interview date and advance in the scholarship selections process, your application and **ALL** other supporting documents must be submitted electronically to scholarship@akronurbanleague.org or dropped off at our offices by **no later than 4:00 p.m. on February 14, 2020.**
