

# UNDER SIEGE: THE PLOT TO DESTROY DEMOCRACY



Using data and analysis from research partner, The Brennan Center for Justice, this year's edition of The State of Black America exposes the four main tactics employed in the plot: gerrymandering, voter suppression, misinformation, and intimidation.

"Politicians have used these tactics for generations, to exclude voters of color and to give their parties an edge," National Urban League President and CEO Marc H. Morial said. "But never before has the nation seen such an insidious and coordinated campaign to obliterate the very principle of 'one person, one vote' from the political process.
